Vertical Spotlights

We identified 5 key areas of innovation.



Scalability and Fairness

As Layer-1 ("L1") see increasing adoption, more projects aim to make blockchains more scalable by batching transactions off-chain and more fair by implementing efficient distribution of Maximal Extractable Value.



Data Usability and Tooling

Data generated on blockchain networks is far from being fully usable by developers. Data querying and indexing services are key innovation areas to improve the current developer experience.



Security and Privacy

The rising demand for network security and privacy has resulted in the emergence of projects aiming to prevent malicious data tracking, smart contract hacks, etc.



Cloud Networks

We see more projects focusing on providing users with access to web-based services that may entail storage, computing, and content delivery through decentralized infrastructure.



Connectivity

L1 blockchains are far from being fully connected and interoperable. Numerous cross-chain solutions are being developed to improve the current on-chain user experience.





Zero-Knowledge (“ZK”):

ZK rollups or Validium protocols execute bundled transactions off-chain and verify it on-chain using zero-knowledge proofs.

	zkSync Era is a ZK rollup solution addressing Ethereum scalability issues with minimized security compromises.
	Manta Pacific is a modular zkEVM built on top of Celestia DA, and Polygon Development Kit (“CDK”). Please note that Manta Pacific is transitioning to a Polygon zkEVM-based L2 as part of its roadmap.
	StarkNet is a decentralised, permissionless ZK rollup developed by Starkware.
	Loopring is a ZK rollup solution primarily for trading and payment.
	Polygon zkEVM is an Ethereum L2 scaling solution that uses ZK proofs to offer validity and quick transaction finality.
	Linea is a zkEVM rollup developed by Consensys, which is also the developer of Metamask.
	Scroll is a native zkEVM solution for Ethereum.

Optimistic:

Protocols that assume the validity of transactions and then combine them to execute off-chain.

	Arbitrum is the largest optimistic rollup network on Ethereum based on total value locked.
	OP Mainnet is a low-cost L2 optimistic rollup network.
	Blast is an L2 network with a feature of native ETH and stablecoin yield.
	Metis is a permissionless optimistic L2 solution developed by MetisDAO Foundation.
	Base is an L2 network launched by Coinbase and built using OP Stack.

Maximal Extractable Value (“MEV”) Solution:

Solutions that prevent validators from unfairly profiting by including, excluding, or reordering transactions in a block.





	Flashbots works on mitigating the negative externalities of current MEV techniques and avoiding the risks that MEV causes to state-rich blockchains.
	Jito Labs builds high-performance systems to scale Solana and maximize validator rewards.
	Eden Network is an optional, non-consensus-breaking, transaction ordering protocol for Ethereum blocks.
	Manifold is a block builder for users and validators on the Ethereum blockchain, aiding in the creation of MEV for all stakeholders.
	Skip Protocol is a MEV infrastructure for blockchains and protocols, currently serving Juno, Evmos, Injective, Injective, Neutron, dYdX, and Berachain..
	Shutter aims to prevent front-running and malicious MEV by using threshold encryption.

RPC is the most direct interface through which developers can communicate with the blockchain system.

 INFURA	Infura provides Ethereum API, IPFS API and Gateway, and ETH nodes-as-a-service.
 moralis	Moralis provides a suite of APIs for developers to seamlessly integrate blockchain into their dApps.
 QuickNode	QuickNode is a platform for developers to scale blockchain applications.
 Ankr	Ankr enables developers to build upon a distributed network of nodes.
 POKT	Pocket Network provides RPC access to Ethereum, Polygon, etc.
 NODEREAL	NodeReal is a one-stop blockchain infrastructure and services provider.


Smart Contract Automation:

Platforms that enable users to automatically execute smart contracts.

 Gelato	Gelato Network enables users to automate smart contract functions on Ethereum.
 OpenZeppelin	OpenZeppelin Relay sends transactions via HTTP API, automating smart contract operations securely.

Data Indexing:

Platforms that provide network data indexing and querying services.


 the graph	The Graph is an indexing protocol for querying networks like Ethereum.
 Covalent	Covalent is a unified API that brings data from different chains and other searchable endpoints.
 Oxs	OxScope is a protocol that aims to standardize Web2 and Web3 data by building a knowledge graph.
 SubQuery	SubQuery offers data indexing on Polkadot, Cosmos, Avalanche, Algorand, NEAR, Ethereum, and more.

Security Solution:

Protocols that contribute to the security of blockchains.

	SharkTeam is a leading Web3 security service provider that offers smart contract audits, chain analytics, and emergency response services.
 Forsta	Forsta is a real-time detection network for security and operational monitoring of blockchain activities.
 OpenZeppelin	OpenZeppelin provides security products to build and operate dApps.
 ImmuneFi	ImmuneFi is a leading bug bounty platform.
 QuantStamp	QuantStamp provides security for hire, protecting over \$200B in digital asset risk from hackers.
 Harpie	Harpie is the first on-chain firewall that protects users from scams, hacks, and theft.

Multisig Wallet:

Cryptocurrency wallets that require two or more private keys to sign and send a transaction.

	Squads is a multisig management protocol for Web3-native teams.

Privacy Solution:

Projects that contribute to the protection of user privacy.

	Nym is a decentralized and tokenized infrastructure that provides privacy from the network to the application layer.
	Anoma is an intent-centric, privacy-preserving protocol for decentralized counterparty discovery, solving, and multi-chain atomic settlement.
	Automata provides a blockchain-based authentication solution that secures access to accounts and protects users with an active defense.
	Hopr is a data-centric privacy tool that prevents bots from accessing the metadata of wallets when users run transactions against a blockchain.

Akash is a decentralized computing marketplace built for public utility.



Render Network provides decentralized GPU-based rendering solutions.

Projects that provide users with access to storage services based on a decentralized infrastructure.



Filecoin

Filecoin is an open-source cloud storage marketplace, protocol, and incentive layer.



Ethereum Swarm is a decentralized storage and communication system.



Sia is a decentralized cloud storage marketplace that allows direct transactions without third parties.



Storj offers low-cost cloud storage with zero-trust security.



Arweave offers permanent and decentralized storage in an open ledger.



BNB Greenfield is a blockchain and storage platform that is EVM-compatible.



Zus is a 3-layer security multi-cloud storage with no vendor lock-in and free egress.

Liquidity

Liquidity staking and collateralized debt positions (“CDPs”) are becoming more prominent, exposing users to a variety of on-chain liquidity opportunities.



Trading

More diverse financial products are being traded on decentralized exchanges (“DEXs”).



Synthetics: Protocols that incorporate cryptocurrencies and traditional derivative assets, essentially tokenized derivatives.

 ALCHEMIX	Alchemix is a DeFi protocol that allows the creation of synthetic tokens that represent the future yield of the deposit.
 Metronome	Metronome allows users to post multi-collateral assets from their portfolio and create a multitude of synthetic assets.

	Venus is a DeFi algorithmic money market protocol on BNB Chain. It is also the largest lending platform on BNB Chain.
	Tectonic, a fork from Compound, is a Cronos-based money market platform for earning passive yield and accessing instant backed loans.
	Radiant is an omnichain money market protocol allowing users to deposit and borrow assets cross-chain.
	Margin.fi is a decentralized lending protocol on Solana with variable interest rates.

ETH Liquid Staking Providers: Protocols that allow users to unlock liquidity through LSDs while keeping networks secure.

	Lybra Finance is a decentralized finance protocol that allows users to mint its overcollateralized, interest-bearing stablecoin, eUSD.
	Prisma Finance is a decentralized, Ethereum-LST backed stablecoin protocol.
	Ethena is a synthetic dollar protocol that allows users to mint its delta-hedged synthetic dollar, USDe.

 Balancer	Balancer is an automated portfolio manager and trading platform on Ethereum.
 SUN	SUN is a platform for stablecoin swap, stake-mining, and self-governance on TRON.

Stream Pay: Payment modules that allow continuous settlement via token streaming.



Launchpad: Composable modules for token issuance, liquidity, etc.

 PinkSale	PinkSale allows users to launch tokens and create their initial token sale.
 team <small>by TrustSwap</small>	Team Finance is a toolkit that helps founders create tokens to raise funds from investors.
 DxSale	DxSale is an initial DEX offering (“IDO”) launchpad.

Marketplace

We see the emergence of NFT marketplaces targeting a variety of use cases, such as chain-specific listings, aggregators, and thematic curations. Users gain access to a wider range of buyer experiences.



Financialization

There are more diverse NFT-based financial products and services, such as staking, lending, derivatives, fractionalization, etc. Users are exposed to liquidity opportunities for their previously illiquid NFT assets.



Services





Derivatives:

Protocols that allow users to trade NFT derivatives.

Buy Now, Pay Later (“BNPL”):

Protocols that allow users to buy NFTs and pay for them later.
